## **CARRIAGE OF AMMUNITION IN HOLD BAGGAGE ON PASSENGER AIRCRAFT**

### **1 SCOPE OF APPLICATION**

This regulation shall be applied to the carriage of ammunition of class 1.4S in hold baggage (checked-in baggage) on passenger aircraft.

### **2 CARRIAGE OF AMMUNITION IN HOLD BAGGAGE**

Passengers may carry ammunition for firearms in their hold baggage only if the ammunition has the UN number UN0012 or UN0014. The UN number is a four-digit number which the United Nations Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods and on the Globally harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals has assigned to the substance or group of substances for the purpose of identification. Ammunition containing explosive or incendiary projectiles may not be carried.

Ammunition for firearms may only be carried for the passenger's own use. The maximum amount of ammunition to be carried shall not exceed a gross weight of 5 kg per person, and combining quantities among passengers is not allowed. The ammunition shall be tightly packed.

Passengers shall notify the air carrier of the intention to carry ammunition in their hold baggage at the time when the baggage is checked in.
